## July Field Trip Nelson's Water Gardens Competition

All photographs entered must have been taken at our club's field trip to Nelson Water Gardens on July 20, 2019.

All photographs entered must be the original work of the entrant. Only digital entries will be accepted. Both vertical and horizontal entries are welcome. Please note that dimensions of the entries are to be 1050 px maximum in the vertical dimension and 1400 px maximum in the horizontal dimension. Max file size 1MB.

File names must include an image title and the entry's photographer's name. The format of the file name will be similar to that of the club's monthly competition, except that the category abbreviation will not be needed. <u>Entrants should retain</u> <u>a higher resolution image of each entry in case they are needed for the</u> <u>printing of the winning images</u>.

The deadline for entry will be 11:59 pm, Thursday, **August 15, 2019.** Entries should be emailed to: Carmen Sewell at <u>csewell3@comcast.net</u>

Each entrant may submit up to three digital images.

All photographs should accurately reflect the subject matter and the scene as it appeared through the viewfinder. Photos that have been digitally altered beyond standard optimization (removal of dust, cropping, reasonable adjustments to exposure, color and contrast, etc.) will be disqualified. Disqualification of entries will be at the discretion of the judge(s). (Competition Continued)

Any subject matter photographed at Nelson Water Gardens is acceptable.

Images will be judged on originality, technical excellence, composition, overall impact and artistic merit. The judging will be done by one or more photographers who are not members of the Houston Photochrome Club.

The identities of the makers of the images will not be disclosed to the judge(s) until the decisions of the judge(s) are final.

By entering the contest, entrants grant permission for Houston Photochrome Club to reproduce, print, or publish any image entered into the contest without compensation, except for the winning prizes noted below. Any entry published on the club's website will receive a credit / copyright symbol line citing its maker.

#### **All Competition Participants**

Images **must** be submitted according to club guidelines or your image may not be included in the monthly competition

Please follow the sizing instructions carefully:

#### NEW INFORMATION 6/14/2018

Please follow the sizing instructions carefully:

A **horizontal image** cannot be longer than **1400 pixels along the horizontal side**;

A **vertical image** cannot be longer than **1050pixels along the vertical side**. ( Vertical images **cannot** be sized **1400** pixels along the vertical side!)

The size of the JPEG image is not to exceed 1MB.( See above for pixel size.)

Rename the image according to the guidelines below. For example:

An Assignment image by John Brown would appear as

AS\_Assignment\_BrownJ.jpg

(Use "M" for Monochrome and "O" for Open categories.)

**DO NOT** use first names, nicknames or initials only, for identification.

Also, the size of the title is limited to 35 characters when naming images. It is important that the guidelines for naming files be followed when submitting images for the monthly competitions otherwise you run the risk of not being credited with your entries.


