Rename the image according to the quidelines below. For example: An Assignment image by John Brown would appear as AS_Assignment_BrownJ.jpg (Use "M" for Monochrome and "O" for Open categories.) DO NOT use first names, nicknames or initials only, for identification. Also, the size of the title is limited to 35
